

## Pupil Premium Statement 2014 - 2015

### Pupil Premium: £58, 500 (2014/15)

Pupil premium is additional Government funding to raise achievement amongst disadvantaged children. It is to help schools to close the gap between children from low income families and other disadvantaged families and their peers.

Pupil premium is for pupils from Reception to Year 11 who are from low income families and are eligible for Free School Meals. Any child that has been registered for Free School Meals over the past six years is eligible. Looked After children also attract another source of funding which is £74.00 per child per term for the school to use to support them.

**Pupil Premium is approximately £1300 for each child who is eligible and schools are expected to use the money to help close attainment gaps for pupils.**

We plan to use these funds to;

- Improve and develop ICT provision in line with the new computing curriculum/new curriculum.
- Continue to provide subsidies for Educational Visits (day trips and residential) so that all pupils can access experience for enrichment and raise aspirations.
- Continue to subsidise wider opportunities to give enrichment in music throughout the school and raise aspirations.
- Booster tuition for Year Six pupils.
- School Tracking System - School Pupil Tracker including training for all new staff.
- Continue to provide a wide range of after school clubs to every child.
- Increase additional adults, to mentor/support pupils where necessary and appropriate and increase Teachers hours.
- To continue to provide staffing for intervention groups for underachieving pupils in Literacy and Maths
- To continue to provide staffing for nurture groups and groups to assist with social skills.
- Purchase resources based on the needs of pupils.
- To continue to subsidise and support families in challenging circumstances according to our knowledge and individual situations.
- Employ an Education Welfare Officer (EWO) to help raise attendance and punctuality across the whole school.
