## Our Transition plan for 2024/25

We are very excited to announce some news for next year and share our transition plans with you. Firstly, consistency for children is our priority, especially as some classes have had a year whereby their class teacher has been ill for a long period or they have experienced a change of teacher. Changing teachers mid-year is never a first choice and whilst I can not always ensure this does not happen, putting plans into place whereby we can reduce the likelihood of this has been our priority. We will be welcoming new staff to St. Mark's and over the next two weeks, they will be in school getting to know children and our school systems.

Due to interviews taking place on Wednesday 17th July, our support staff will be announced at a later date. Our support staff have a wealth of experience and varied skill sets so it is important to us that we wait until we have all members of our team for September before making any decisions.



It brings me great pleasure to announce that Miss Dorsett is expecting a baby and her baby is due in the Autumn term. Mr. Linford, who is already familiar with the school, will be joining the St. Mark's team as temporary Assistant Principal from September. This is so that we can ensure there is a smooth transition when Miss Dorsett takes her maternity leave.

To support our children to get to know their new class teachers, we have planned a transition day for **Tuesday 16th July**. On this day, your child will meet their new class teacher and learn about what they can expect from their new year groups. As Mr. Linford will be joining us in September, our new Year 4 class will be spending their transition day with Mrs. Khan only. They will have time in September to meet Mr Linford and get to know him too.



In September, you will be able to meet your child's new class teacher as there will be a transition meeting with parents whereby the expectations for the year ahead will be explained. Dates will be given out early in September for this.

#### ARBOR PARENT APP



Can all parents please ensure they have downloaded the Arbor app to gain access to the Parent Portal.

The Parent app can be downloaded from either the Playstore on android phones or App store on i-phones.

We are hoping to start adding payment items on Arbor, and therefore require all parents to create an account as soon as possible.

#### New Electric Gates

Last week we saw the completion of our new electric gates. This was a huge part of our work to ensure children's safety when in and around school. If you wish to access the main office, and the pedestrian gate is not open, please press the alarm button. A member of school staff will then open the gate. It is vital that you do not push or pull the gate as this will break the mechanism.

The school car park is only to be used by school staff and <u>MUST NOT</u> be used by parents. It is important that parents <u>DO NOT</u> block the gates at any time, even after the school day has finished. We do have improved security cameras on the gates and car park and this will be monitored closely.
